As the regulatory body for Newfoundland and Labrador's Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs), the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Newfoundland and Labrador (CLPNNL) sets the requirements for LPN education and licensing, as well as the Standards of Practice and Code of Ethics. The CLPNNL is accountable to protect the public through the promotion of safe, competent, compassionate and ethical nursing care.

The CLPNNL is seeking a Regulatory Officer who will support the Registrar on matters concerning regulation, including the disciplinary process, licensure, education program approval, the Continuing Competency Program auditing process, as well as the credential assessment and validation processes. In addition, the Regulatory Officer will support the Practice Consultant on matters related to professional practice. The Regulatory Officer will work under the direction of the Registrar.

Requirements:

- Current licensure or eligibility for licensure with the CLPNNL;
- 5 years recent clinical experience as a LPN;
- Clinical experience in multiple areas of practice (Acute Care, Long Term Care and Community);
- Excellent leadership, organizational, advanced communication (written & oral), interpersonal and problem-solving skills;
- A clear understanding of the Licensed Practical Nurses Act, Regulations, Standards of Practice, Scope of Practice and Code of Ethics for the profession;
- Proficiency in the use of computers and Microsoft Office (Word, Outlook Express, Excel, PowerPoint and Access);
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with other professionals, members of the public and stakeholders;
- Well-developed analytical skills and the ability to be resourceful and attentive to detail;
- Initiative, sound judgment and assertiveness;
- Ability to adjust to multiple demands in a changing environment;
- Ability and willingness to travel as required.

Additional education beyond the Practical Nurse diploma program would be considered an asset. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. Remuneration is commensurate with education and experience. CLPNNL provides a full benefit package including membership in the provincial government pension plan.
