

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY LICENSE IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 FOR LPNs NOT CURRENTLY IN PRACTICE

An emergency temporary license is available for practical nurses who wish to return to nursing practice during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The emergency temporary license is only for the purpose of returning to practice to assist in response to COVID-19.

The emergency temporary license is not for those who intend to obtain ongoing employment in NL.

The emergency temporary license for COVID-19 response is for **3 months** with a possible extension.

Who Can Apply?

To be eligible for an emergency temporary license in relation to COVID-19 response, the applicant must:

- Have previously been licensed with CLPNNL or
- Currently hold a license to practice in another Canadian Jurisdiction.
- If not currently, or previously, licensed have successfully completed a program of education for practical nurses approved by the CLPNNL Board in Canada within the past 12 months and have not failed a writing of the approved practical nurse licensure exam.

4 Steps to Apply
